From the North

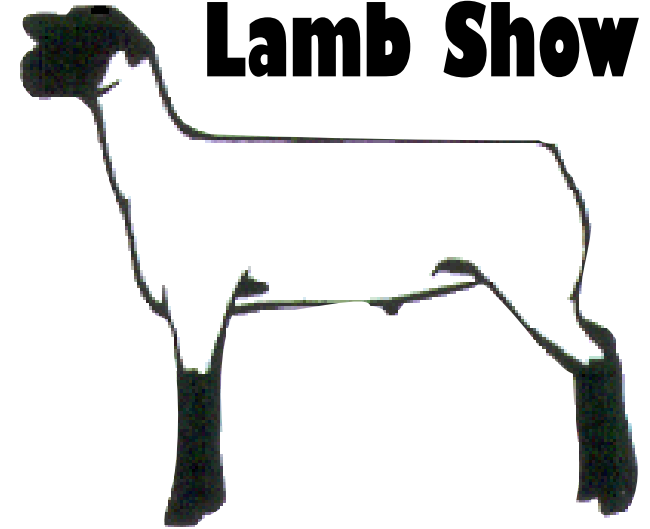

General Rules

(Please note changes are underlined)

1. The 2009 Badger Bonanza is a Wisconsin Club Lamb Association sanctioned show.
2. Wether and ewe lambs are eligible to compete and will be shown together.
3. Open to exhibitors under 19 years of age as of January 1st, with unlimited entries per exhibitor.
4. Lambs will be classified according to the All-American Junior Show Classification System.
5. Classes will be spilt according to breed, weight, and number of entries. The Show Committee reserves the right to set classes.
6. White Faced Breeds will be shown in White Faced AOBs, if less than 5 animals are entered.
7. Speckled and/or Black Faced AOB lambs must show in the Crossbred division, unless they are classified as a Suffolk, Hampshire or Natural.
8. The International Association of Fairs and Exhibitions National Code of Ethics will be followed.
9. No dyeing, drenching, spray painting, or icing of lamb prior to, or during the show is allowed.
10. Show officials reserve the right to make final interpretations of the show rules.
11. There are no pens supplied by the show, we apologize for the inconvenience.
12. Sexually-intact sheep of any age, and all other sheep twelve months of age and older, must be identified with official scrapie ear tags. All ewe lambs must have a scrapie tag.
13. Out-of-state animals must have health papers.
14. All lambs must be individually identified on the health paper with an official ID.
15. The WI Department of Agriculture, Trade, & Consumer Protection requires that the show committee retain a copy of out-of-state health certificates, please bring a copy for the show committee to keep.
16. A veterinarian will be present to inspect all lambs prior to unloading from trailers.
17. Regardless of health papers, all lambs showing symptoms of contagious diseases will be eliminated from the show. Such diseases include, but are not limited to sore mouth, ringworm, foot rot, pinkeye and wool fungus. All animals on the same trailer or in the same vehicle will be dismissed as well.
18. All health rules are subject to the interpretation of the show veterinarian.

19. Decisions made by the judge, classifier, show veterinarian, and/or show officials are final.

20. All entries are made at the show and are non-refundable.

21. The University of Wisconsin Saddle & Sirloin Club is not liable for any accidents, damages, or losses.

22. All exhibitors must sign and return a copy of the Liability Release before they will be allowed to show. Copies will be available at the show. Please bring a signed copy if a parent will not be in attendance for those below 18 years of age.
